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TEMPORARY SIGN PERMIT CONDITIONS

- 1. The sign installation requirements outlined in Appendices A and B must be strictly adhered to.
- 2. The City reserves the right to remove and dispose of signs that are not installed in accordance with the installation guidelines provided in Appendices A and B.
- 3. The City reserves the right to remove temporary signs at any time without consulting the applicant.
- 4. The City reserves the right to remove any signs improperly located, installed, damaged or defaced in any way.
- 5. No more than three Temporary Sign Permits will be issued per time period and priority will be determined based on a first-come-first-served basis.
- 6. Signage will be advertising a non-profit or fundraising event (cannot be associated with elections or political activity).
- 7. Signage shall be installed only in the specified areas designated in Appendix A, according to the size installation guidelines provided in Appendix B.


SIGN INSTALLATION GUIDELINES FOR TEMPORARY SIGNS ON STREETS (Under Authority of Bylaw No. 6234)

General

• The temporary signage permitted at the approved location must be freestanding with no more than two sign faces and fabricated using a weatherproof material, supported by two legs inserted into the grass.

Size of Sign

- The overall sign dimensions must be no greater than 0.9 metres (3.0 feet) in height, and 1.2 metres (4.0 feet) in width.
- When installed, the top of temporary signage must be no greater than 1.4 metres (4.5 feet) above grade.



Mounting and Installation of Sign

- Signage must be fabricated using coroplast, plastic or similar lightweight material
- Signage must be securely fastened to two wire legs (or similar, as determined by CNV staff)
- Signage legs may be inserted no more than 30 centimetres (1.0 foot) into the grass

Duration of Sign Installation

• Signage may be installed for a maximum of two weeks
