



REGULATIONS UNDER THE SAFETY STANDARDS ACT

Permits that may be issued by a local government (Section 23 of the Gas Safety Regulations)

If a local government administers a gas inspection service under an agreement under section 5 of the Act, a safety officer appointed by the local government may issue an installation permit for only the following kinds of regulated work in respect of gas equipment of gas systems:

- a) regulated work in a fully detached dwelling serviced by an individual service meter and supplied with gas at a pressure of 14.0 kPa gauge or less;
- b) regulated work in any premises other than a fully detached dwelling, if;
 - (i) the meter is supplied with gas at a pressure of 14.0 kPa gauge or less, and
 - (ii) the total connected load for the meter is 120 kW or less.

Homeowner may perform work under a permit (Section 24 of the Gas Safety Regulations)

- (1) A homeowner may apply for an installation permit to perform regulated work with respect to gas equipment in a fully detached dwelling if
 - a) no person is being paid to do, or assist the owner in doing, the work, and
 - b) no part of the dwelling is rented to any person
