COMMEMORATION OF THE 80TH ANNIVERSARY OF D-DAY AND THE CAMPAIGN TO LIBERATE FRANCE

Whereas

on June 6, 1944 the allied invasion of the coast of Normandy France, code named, "Operation Overlord" began and came to a successful close on August 31, 1994;

Whereas

we recognize the citizen soldiers who were members of North Vancouver's Sixth Field Company who participated in the D-Day landings and liberation campaign, of which 5,000 died and more than 13,000 who suffered wounds;

we celebrate the legacy of peace and freedom enjoyed by the people of the Republic of France that was enabled by the enormous sacrifice made by North Vancouver's citizens:
