ON COLLECTION DAY

On collection day, place materials at the curb between 5:30 and 7:30am. Do not place items out the night before.

MANAGING AND SORTING MATERIAL



GARBAGE: BI-WEEKLY (EVERY OTHER WEEK) PICKUP

- Maximum of two 77 L garbage cans
- Maximum 20 KG per can



- Maximum of six Green Cans, bags and bundles in total
- Maximum 20 KG per can, bundle or bag
- Bundle twigs and branches, maximum 1 M long
- No plastic, biodegradable or compostable plastic bags, cutlery, containers or packaging.



RECYCLING: WEEKLY PICKUP

- Yellow bag: paper and cardboard
- Blue box: metal and plastic containers
- Grey box: glass containers

Where do I get a garbage or Green Can? Residents are responsible for providing their own garbage and Green Can.

What type of container should I use for garbage and Green Cans?

Containers should be cylindrical, watertight, with a fitted and non-hinged lid, with a capacity of 77 L. Green Cans should have a decal.

You can help prevent wildlife encounters by responsibly managing waste and other attractants.


STORE IT: Keep curbside materials in a secure location until collection day.

FREEZE IT: To reduce odours, freeze food scraps until collection day.

CLEAN IT: To reduce odours, rinse or wash containers after pickup.
